#### **SUMMARY**


Timor-Leste ranks 112th in the Open Data Inventory with a total score of 16/100. The total score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 27/100 and a data openness subscore of 5/100.

Timor-Leste scores lower than the regional median across all three major data categories. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on economic statistics and the lowest levels are on environmental statistics.

Looking across all 20 data categories, Timor-Leste provides the best coverage on: International Trade and National Accounts, and the least coverage on, but not limited to: Education Facilities and Money & Banking.

In terms of openness, Timor-Leste receives the highest scores on, but not limited to: Population & Vital Statistics and Health Facilities, and the lowest scores on, but not limited to: Education Facilities and Education Outcomes.
