*Note: This information is extracted from the latest Fortune Global 500 magazine dated 25 July 2005. Fortune uses Profit After Tax in calculating Returns on Revenues and Returns on Assets. PETRONAS on the other hand, uses Profit Before Tax in calculating Returns on Revenues and Returns on Assets on the basis that different countries have different tax regimes, resulting in Returns on Revenues of 42.3% and Returns on Assets of 24.3%.*
